Registrations: Registration and pre-payment are required. The workshop is open to scouts from any pack or troop. Bring a lunch, and wear shoes and clothing appropriate for activities outdoors. Badge events are held rain or shine.

Fee: The cost is \$5.00 per scout. Parents and chaperones are free. Fees are due two weeks after the reservation is made or the reservation will be canceled.
